Key Events and Initiatives

Networking Events:

These events will be hosted by the SSE to foster connectivity and visibility amongst Somali engineers and to provide an avenue for Somali engineering students and early career engineers to meet and network with peers and potential mentors.

Career Fairs:

The SSE will coordinate with members of the society to conduct career expos and fairs at local high schools to introduce and promote engineering education and practice to highschoolers preparing to apply to college.

Resume and Career Counseling:

SSE will conduct regular seminars and training from engineering students and the general public on different engineering career paths and to provide assistance and mentorship for resume building and career planning and development.

Scholarship Drives:

SSE will host quarterly scholarship drives to provide assistance to Somali Engineering students in college and highschoolers applying to colleges to assist with cost incurring items such as application fees, FE exam fees, and tuition.

Annual Conference:

Every year, SSE hosts a national conference to celebrate the success of our members and accomplishments of local students and conduct drives for scholarships for local students. We award these merit-based scholarships to graduating high-school seniors entering college as well as current college students pursuing a degree in STEM to facilitate more access to the Somali community into the engineering world.
